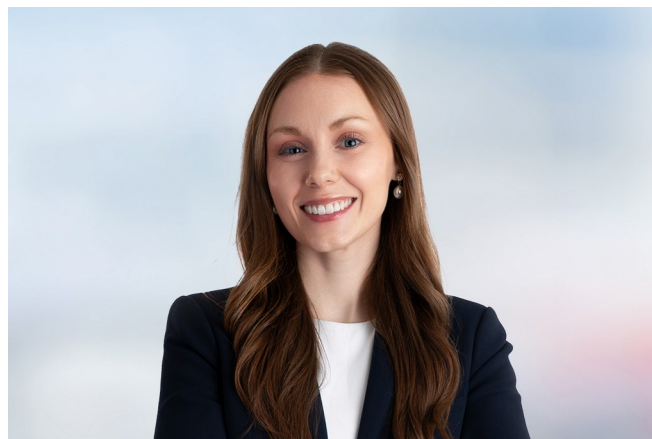


Annie Boeckers
