

The Supreme Court - April 26, 2021

Today, the Supreme Court of the United States granted certiorari in three cases:

Houston Community College System v. Wilson, No. 20-804: Does the First Amendment restrict the authority of an elected body to issue a censure resolution in response to a member's speech?

United States v. Zubaydah, No. 20-827: Whether the court of appeals erred when it rejected the United States' assertion of the state-secrets privilege based on the court's own assessment of potential harms to the national security, and required discovery to proceed further under 28 U.S.C. §1782(a) against former Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) contractors on matters concerning alleged clandestine CIA activities.

New York State Rifle v. Corlett, No. 20-843: Whether the State's denial of petitioners' applications for concealed-carry licenses for self-defense violated the Second Amendment.
